## January 2018 — News from CPC in The Hill

**2017 CHRISTMAS STORE** — This year's annual Hill Christmas Store was successful at many levels. Each year our anchor church, CPC New Haven, and CPC in The Hill join together to offer our Hill neighbors the ability to buy up to five brand new Christmas presents for their children. Unlike other Christmas toy "giveaways," parents pay for these presents, which adds to the dignity and joy they'll have on Christmas morning when they see their kids open the presents *they* purchased. The items are donated by the anchor church and our Hill congregation and then marked down significantly (up to 80%). For \$25 a parent can buy up to five brand new items for their kids. We had more donated this year, which is greatly appreciated. The snow didn't stop people from coming; in fact, the snow slowed them down and many just hung out—which allowed for more talking and sharing with them about CPC in The Hill and why we do this. And, the time spent among our two congregations is priceless and is a demonstration that we are one CPC church.





CHRISTMAS @ THE ANDERSONS — Each year Lisa and I invite CPC in The Hill and their families to join us at our house in Bridgeport, about 30 minutes away from the Hill. The kids enjoyed the White Elephant gift exchange; people talk and share more deeply; and, family members and guests find themselves welcomed into this moment of CPC fellowship. It's quite the adventure. Only a few people have cars—so transportation and timing is critical. Events like this one illustrate the fullness of the CPC in The Hill family. Our house was very full this year. We had over 30 in the house (literally in just two rooms). Close quarters makes for closer fellowship! This event highlights our need and desire to move to The Hill—so that next year will be A Hill Christmas @ The Andersons. Pray God provides the funding, the new home in The Hill, and the timing. Help us get there!

NEW YEAR'S EVE WATCH SERVICE — CPC in The Hill ends each year and begins the New with a Watch Service stretched between 10pm and 1am. One of the traditions we started at my first Hill Watch Service is to use our time of confession to write on sticky notes the sins, issues, and things God has been dealing with throughout the year—asking forgiveness and believing God assuredly forgives. The sticky-notes are then walked up to a small wooden cross set nearby and posted on the cross, symbolizing that God's good grace in Jesus' death covers all our sins and heals our wounds, failings, and weaknesses. As the New Year rolled in, we again pray, thanking God for working in us and anticipating what God will do through us for our families and neighborhoods. This year about a dozen kids (yes, kids) joined us—they also wrote on stickynotes (after a little extended explanation on sin and our confession) and were the first to go and stick their notes on the cross.

**FINANCIAL GOAL UPDATE** — This year, Sept 1, 2017–Aug 31, 2018, Lisa and I will need to raise \$40,000 to help cover expenses. As of 12/31 we are at 61% pledged or given toward our financial goal and responsibility for this year's budget, leaving \$15,600 to be pledged or donated. Let me emphasize, pledges are very important in that pledges (for either annual, quarterly, or monthly) helps us to budget and allocate funds to our growing activities and ministries.

ANOTHER WAY TO THINK ABOUT OUR SUPPORT NEEDS — Thank you for getting us, at this point, to 61% given or pledged to meet our financial responsibilities for the continued and the building of our Hill church plant and ministry. Per month we need to have \$3,243 of outside support to cover ministry expenses; the gifts and pledges thus far has enabled us to see \$1,978 in our monthly outside giving, leaving a need for \$1,300 additional monthly support. Please consider who else you might know and what other churches might also consider supporting our Hill church plant and ministry.
