**December Monthly Update on our Financial Resources**—As of December 15<sup>th</sup>, we are at 50% (or \$21,960) pledged or given toward our FY19 responsibility (\$43,463) for the necessary resources for our Hill church plant and ministry. Our goal is to see a monthly fundraising income of \$3,620. *If all pledges and anticipated donations come in*, we are currently at \$1,830 (or 50% of our monthly needed amount).
