Consider partnering with the Anderson's Ministry in the Hill. For the next 4 years we need approximately \$127,000 annually for the ministry.

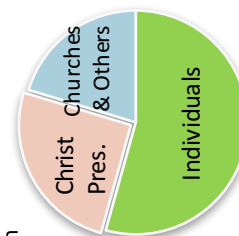

PARTNER with 200 who will pray regularly for us and our ministry in The Hill community and with 100 individuals who will help support our ministry through regular donations.

ESTABLISH a vibrant and sustainable *Five Mark Total Christ Church* (Christ Centered, Missional, Confessional, Sacramental, Communal) in The Hill community of New Haven, CT.

OUTREACH to the community through intentional evangelistic and community development activities.

DISCIPLE members to help them grow in Christ and to discover their gifts so that CPC in The Hill matures to the full measure of Jesus.

EMPOWER Hill members and leaders to engage in church planting, personal and family growth, and community development to help The Hill flourish.



New Haven, CT is a mid-sized city with remarkable breadth and depth of racial and socio-economic diversity. *According to the 2012 Census, however, it has one of the highest child poverty rates in the country (43.7%).*

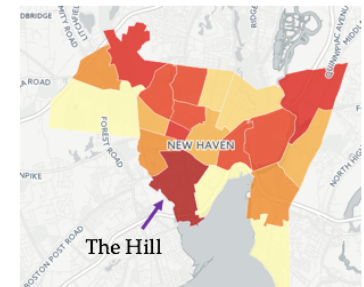
With a population of over 861,113, the greater **New Haven** area is home to seven colleges and universities, known for one of the finest healthcare systems in the US, and is renown for its performing arts, museums, and great restaurants. But, *it ranks dangerously high in violent crime and drug use on the official FBI Crime Report.*



The Hill community of New Haven, CT is home to the majority of Yale-New Haven Hospital and Yale Medical School facilities. *Yet, the majority of residential areas of The Hill are the working-poor and minority individuals and families that face the effects of poverty, high unemployment, food scarcity, and unstable housing.*



The community known as **the Hill** in New Haven, Connecticut is primarily a low-income, working-poor, and minority neighborhood.
