




NEWS FROM CPC IN THE HILL—DECEMBER 2019

A QUILT MADE BY OUR KIDS IN THE SUMMER PRESENTED BY OUR KIDS FOR A **NEEDY FAMILY FOR THE WINTER—**Last summer, during our Soccer & Art Camp, the kids fashioned a quilt. The theme of the camp was G.R.A.C.E., God's Riches at Christ's Expense, was woven into the quilt squares. After it was presented at Camp closing, the intention of the kids and camp counselors was to give the quilt to someone in need that could use a blanket. The decision was made to donate the quilt to Christian Community Action (from whom we rent our worship space), who



could identify one of their shelter families that would have need of such a blanket for the winter months. On the Sunday before Christmas our CPC in



Our CPC in The Hill kids practiced for a few weeks and at our Christmas service read the Christmas story from the Gospels of Luke and Matthew. This is how God changes things.

Update on our Financial Resources—We are grateful to our financial partners for their support, which is currently at 67% of our FY20 goal. We are still in need of pledges and/or one time gifts for the remaining leaving 33% or \$15,642 remaining to be raised for FY20 ministry budget responsibilities. (Again, our budget year began in September '19 and will end in August '20). On a weekly basis, we need to see \$3,950 from outside sources each month; currently, from pledges and one-time gifts, we are at \$2,646 p/mo, needing now to secure an additional \$1,304 p/mo of pledges or one time gifts to ensure we have the resources for the remainder of the FY.

Our budget is very austere, but still needed to keep me full time and to provide the necessary resources for CPC in The Hill ministries. *Please consider* helping us meet our ministry needs for FY20 and become a financial partner with us in reaching our Hill neighbors for Christ.
